

**The Dell Technologies World Experience Game Sweepstakes
OFFICIAL RULES**

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. YOU HAVE NOT YET WON. SWEEPSTAKES OPEN TO ATTENDEES OF DELL TECHNOLOGIES WORLD EXPERIENCE: (A) WHO ARE AT LEAST EIGHTEEN (18) OF AGE (19 IN AL, DE AND NE; 21 IN MS), OR (B) HAVE REACHED THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THEIR STATE/PROVINCE/TERRITORY OF RESIDENCE, AT THE DATE OF ENTRY INTO SWEEPSTAKES. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

SWEEPSTAKES DEFINITION – Outside of the U.S.: Sweepstakes’ as defined in these Rules is the equivalent of a ‘Prize Draw’. If applicable within a jurisdiction, references to ‘Sweepstakes’ herein and in connection with a promotion, shall be read as and understood to mean ‘Prize Draw’.

1. Agreement to Official Rules: By entering the Dell Technologies World Experience Game Sweepstakes (the “Sweepstakes”) Entrant hereby fully and unconditionally agrees to these official rules (the “Official Rules”) and Sponsor's decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein. Any violation of these Official Rules will result in disqualification.

2. Eligibility: The Sweepstakes is open only to attendees of Dell Technologies World Experience held October 21-22, 2020 who are: (a) at least eighteen (18) years old (nineteen (19) in AL, DE and NE; twenty-one (21) in MS), or (b) have reached the age of majority in state/province/territory of residence, at the date of entry into the Sweepstakes. Employees and representatives of Dell Inc., Intrado or BDA, including any subsidiaries, and their parent and affiliate companies as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings and children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible. Government employees including all federal, state, county, city or municipal government employees, state funded universities and colleges, all types of public officials including elected officials, private individual or firms where the government has outsourced government functions, and K-12 employees are not eligible. VOID IN ALL JURISDICTIONS WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW OR REGULATION, AND JURISDICTIONS WITH LAWS THAT WOULD REQUIRE REGISTRATION, TRUST ACCOUNT, AND/OR POSTING OF A BOND, OR ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN SATISFIED, OR RESTRICTED OR TAXED BY LAW OR CONTRARY TO LOCAL LAWS. Residents of an Excluded state/province/territory are not eligible. Participation constitutes Entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and Sponsor’s decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein.

3. Sponsor: Dell Marketing L.P., One Dell Way, Round Rock, TX 78682.

4. Timing: The Sweepstakes begins on October, 21st, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. CDT and ends on October 22nd, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. CDT (the "Entry Period").

5. How to Enter: An Attendee must complete all four (4) badges while logged in to the Dell Technologies World Experience by following the criteria outlined below. Completion of all four badges earns one entry into the Sweepstakes with two opportunities to win.

Badges and completion criteria:

Experience badge: Attendee must log in and attend Dell Technologies World Virtual Event on October 21st, 2020 and October 22nd, 2020 to complete this badge.

Learn badge: Attendee must log-in and attend any 3 content sessions (Keynote Session, Guru session, or Breakout session) within a session player for at least 5 min in order to complete this badge.

Connect badge: Attendee must visit any 5 sponsor pages within the Connect area of the event to complete this badge.

Intel Sponsor badge: Attendee must attend Intel's On-Demand Sponsor Session, "The New Face of Business Client Computing – Powering Your Greatest Contribution" which can be navigated to from the Agenda or Intel's Sponsor Page.

Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited and will result in disqualification. In the event of a dispute as to any registration, the authorized account holder of the email address used to register will be deemed to be the registrant or player. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. The potential winner may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder.

6. Prize Redemption Spinner: After the Sweepstakes has closed, Attendees who have completed all four (4) badges will be sent a link, via email, to the Prize Redemption Spinner to redeem their prize item. Attendees will have 48 hours from receipt of the email to redeem their prize using the Prize Redemption Spinner. Attendees that have completed all 4 badges will also be entered and eligible for the Grand Prize Drawing.

7. Grand Prize Drawings: On or around October 23rd, 2020, Sponsor will conduct a random drawing to select a Grand Prize winner from all eligible entries. The potential winner will be notified by email.

8. Prize Winner Requirements: Each potential winner will be required to sign and return to **Sponsor**, within ten (10) days of the date notice or attempted notice is sent, an Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability Release (for any prize valued over US \$20) and the Grand Prize Winner will also be required to return a completed tax form as required for winner's country of residence, in order to claim a prize.
